TERMS-Applicant agrees to comply with and be bound by the following terms and conditions, Applicant shall; Only display items suitable to the character of a high quality antiques show-management reserves the right to determine suitable items, those not meeting standards must be removed immediately; Tag each item displayed. The tag shall be prominently displayed and contain the following information; A. Detail on all repairs, marriages and restoration, if any; B. Age of item; C. Not to display any dollar items or markdowns; D. Not to set up any displays under the tables. E. Not display any items outside your designated display area. F. Not display any items in a manner that violates fire codes or expo center policies. Any merchandise violating either fire codes or expo center policies must be removed immediately or exhibitor will be subject to removal from show and or fine. 2. SALES RECEIPTS-applicant shall not sell any item at the show without a sales receipt listing the applicants name, address, phone number and the date of sale, the purchase price and a detailed description of the items sold. 3. PACKING-Applicant shall not disassemble or pack items in the booth (other than items sold) until 5:00 p.m. on the Saturday of the show. 4. HOLD HARMLESS- Applicant agrees to hold Atlanta Antiques and Design Market harmless on any agreement, dispute, controversy, or lawsuit concerning any item sold, displayed, traded or in any manner exchanged during or as a result of the show. 5. ATTENDANCE AT BOOTH- Applicant agrees that the booth rented shall be attended by applicant or employees of applicant during all times that the show is open to the public. 6. ATLANTA ANTIQUES AND DESIGN MARKET LIABILITY-Atlanta Antiques and Design Market shall not be responsible for any loss that may arise to the Applicant, his employees or his goods. 7. CANCELLATIONS- Atlanta Antiques and Design Market may cancel this contract any time by written notice to the applicant. If Atlanta Antiques and Design Market cancels the contract, the Applicants application fee shall be returned and Applicant waives any rights to damage beyond the return of the application fee. Application fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. 8. CONVENANTS OF THE-Atlanta Antiques and Design Market- shall provide: A. Provide porters to assist the applicants in loading and unloading display items. The porters are independent contractors and Atlanta Antiques and Design Market assumes no liability for their actions. B. Parking spaces for the Applicants vehicle. DEALERS WILL PARK IN SPECIFIED DEALER PARKING AREA 9. APPLICATION FEES AND PAYMENT- Applicant submits herewith \_\_\_\_\_ (\$100 per space) as an application fee which will be applied to the use of the booth. The balance due under this contract shall be due and payable no later than the first day of set-up. 10. ASSIGNMENTS- Applicant may not assign this contract. 11. DEFAULT- That in the event of default of any terms of the contract by the applicant, Atlanta Antiques and Design Market shall not only be entitled to compensation damages but to any and all cost including but not limited to attorney fees. 12. APPLICABLE LAW- Parties agree that this application and contract shall be interpreted and enforced pursuant to the law of the state of Georgia. 1. This show is by invitation only. Exhibitor agrees to leave and not return upon request of the Atlanta Antiques and Design Markets management. Inappropriate merchandise, swearing, vulgarity and crass behavior is not tolerated.
2. No firearms except those manufactured before 1899 are to be displayed or sold, and these firearms must be unloaded and tied inoperable. Loose ammo, bulk black powder, bombs, grenades, etc. are not allowed.
3. Exhibitors selling jewelry must leave their merchandise locked in an appropriate safe, or take their merchandise with them at all times when leaving their booth.
4. Pets are not allowed, unless they are caged at all times. The exception is a service animal. Should a service animal or caged animal cause any problem it will be disallowed.
5. Anyone driving on the grounds must be appropriately licensed and insured. No cell phones are to be used while driving on the grounds. While driving in the buildings drivers are required to have all windows down with radios off, have a foot on brakes at all times and comply with a speed limit of 2 MPH. Outside of the buildings drivers are required to comply with a speed limit of 5 MPH.
6. Exhibitors are strictly prohibited from bringing shoppers into the building(s) under the pretense of helping to unload or set-up displays before the show is open to the public.
7. Minors are to be accompanied by a responsible adult.
8. Aisle-ways must be kept clear at all times. Exhibitors must keep all merchandise within the confines of their booth markings.
9. Dangerously hot exhibit lighting (such as halogen), heaters, combustible or explosive materials (such as propane), items stacked high that could fall, or tall unstable items (like mirrors), items displayed low that could cause tripping, extremely sharp items, or anything that may pose a danger to the public is not allowed inside the facilities or on the grounds. Two-piece furniture or similar items must be secured. All fabric coverings, including table covers and backdrops, must be flame retardant. You may be required to produce proof for fire officials. You must not block fire equipment, including fire extinguishers, utility rooms, and pedestrian doors.
17. All walls and wall type backdrops are limited to six(6) feet in height, and must be appropriately secured by exhibitor.
18. Nails and screws are not be used on the walls or the floors. Extension cords must be flat (not round), be securely taped down (not twisted) with red/orange tape, and meet fire codes.
19. If an exhibitor uses a tent as part of their display they are solely responsible for the securing of that tent and for any damages that may result from failing to do so.
20. Porters work for exhibitors as independent contractors for a pre-agreed amount. Fair pay should be approximately \$15.00 per hour. Should you have any problems with porters demanding more please take the information to the front desk.
21. All exhibitors are to leave their parking permit visible in the windshield while parked on the grounds.
22. Everyone is requested to be vigilant and to immediately report any problems such as; a breach in security, thefts, injury, and/or damage to property or merchandise to the show staff. .
23. Neither alcohol nor illegal drugs are permitted on the grounds at any time.
24. Exhibitors are responsible for loss and/or liabilities of their merchandise, and securing valuable items.
25. Exhibitors will indemnify and save harmless the show staff, Atlanta Antiques and Design Markets against loss or damages to persons or properties.
26. Breakdown of booth is not permitted until 5:00 pm on Saturday
27. Exhibitor agrees to leave booth clear of excessive trash. Otherwise he/she may be billed for extra clean up.
